- Scroll to the section 'Notices & Events' and go to the notice 'Bodyke Church Live Services'. In that notice click the
 link 'BodykeChurch' which will take you to the live service and you will also be able to see previously broadcast
 Masses. You do not need a Facebook account to watch the Mass.
- If you do have a Facebook account follow the 'Bodyke Church' page which will bring you to online Masses.
- The broadcast usually begins about five minutes before Mass is due to begin.

Current restrictions:

- Please continue to observe guidelines for public health and safety. It is important to stay at home; be responsible, sanitise and wear a face mask.
- Churches are open for private prayer if you visit please be considerate of others and wipe seat and surfaces afterwards.
- Mass is available online everyday except Saturday at 10am.
- Please use the online donation button on the Killaloe Diocese website to make a contribution to the parish. All funds go directly to the parish. Arrangements for distribution of new boxes of envelopes will be made when restrictions ease.

Sacraments: Unfortunately we are as yet unable to set a date for any sacramental celebrations this year. Please check the website and newsletter for further information in coming weeks.

The Presentation of the Lord, 2nd February, is also World Day of Consecrated Life. This feast recalls how Simeon recognised Christ as the Light to reveal God to the nations and so we light candles on this day. It has been traditional to leave candles for blessing in church and for use in church at this time of year. You are welcome to do so and they will be blessed at 10am Mass in Bodyke on Tuesday.

The Feast of St Blaise takes place on 3rd February – he is venerated as patron of those suffering from disease of the throat and it would usually be the day on which throats are blessed. This is not possible to do so physically this year, but Fr David will give the blessing online during Mass on Wednesday morning. Offer the prayer of blessing to others on the day: "Through the intercession of St Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from all ailments of the throat and from every other evil."

Novena to Our Lady of Lourdes: As we prepare for the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes on Thursday 11th February, World Day of Prayer for the Sick, The Franciscan Pilgrimage and the Killaloe Diocesan Pilgrimage will host a Novena of Prayer.
