- Scroll to the section 'Notices & Events' and go to the notice 'Bodyke Church Live Services'. In that notice click the link 'BodykeChurch' which will take you to the live service and you will also be able to see previously broadcast Masses. You do not need a Facebook account to watch the Mass.
- If you do have a Facebook account follow the 'Bodyke Church' page which will bring you to online Masses.
- The broadcast usually begins about five minutes before Mass is due to begin.

Current restrictions:

- Please continue to observe guidelines for public health and safety. It is important to stay at home; be responsible, sanitise and wear a face mask.
- Churches are open for private prayer if you visit please be considerate of others and wipe seat and surfaces afterwards.
- Mass is available online everyday except Saturday at 10am. •
- Please use the online donation button on the Killaloe Diocese website to make a contribution to the parish. All funds go directly to the parish. Arrangements for distribution of new boxes of envelopes will be made when restrictions ease. If you wish to donate by your bank please contact parish office for details.

Ash Wednesday - 17 Feb - is the beginning of Lent. Ashes will be blessed during the 10am Mass on Wednesday and this can be viewed online. Unfortunately the distribution of ashes cannot take place in the usual manner. Blessed ashes will be available in each of the churches; you are welcome to take them home and if you wish, make the sign of the cross on your own forehead (and that of your family) using these words: 'Repent and believe in the Gospel'. Trócaire: Please pick up a Trócaire box or make your own into which you can place your offering through the season of Lent. This year's theme is 'War has taken enough...please help this Lent'. Masses: Remember you can play back previous Masses anytime from the Bodyke Church page, easy to access through the website.

Many thanks: Thanks to those who painted the interior of St Mary's Church over the past few weeks - it is much appreciated. We are waiting for the go-ahead for builders to recommence non-essential work and soon after that St Molua's roof will be repaired followed by painting of the church interior. Sacraments: There have been a number of inquiries about dates of sacramental celebrations; unfortunately we are not in a position to set any dates and it will likely be early March before we are able to do so.
