To watch Mass online from Bodyke church

- Go to www.bodyketuamgraneyparish.ie
- Scroll to the section 'Notices & Events' and go to the notice 'Bodyke Church Live Services'. In that notice click the link 'BodykeChurch' which will take you to the live service and you will also be able to see previously broadcast Masses. You do not need a Facebook account to watch the Mass.
- If you do have a Facebook account follow the 'Bodyke Church' page which will bring you to online Masses.
- The broadcast usually begins about five minutes before Mass is due to begin.

Current restrictions:

- Please continue to observe guidelines for public health and safety. It is important to stay at home; be responsible, sanitise and wear a face mask.
- Churches are open for private prayer if you visit please be considerate of others and wipe seat and surfaces afterwards.
- Mass is available online everyday except Saturday at 10am.
- Please use the online donation button on the Killaloe Diocese website to make a contribution to the parish. All funds go directly to the parish. Arrangements for distribution of new boxes of envelopes will be made when restrictions ease. If you wish to donate by your bank please contact parish office for details.

New boxes of envelopes for church collections are being distributed at the moment. We appreciate the help of those who delivered the boxes and your continued generosity is very much appreciated.

Masses: A reminder that Mass is available online at 10am each morning through the parish website and you can watch the mass later during the day at the same site.

Lenten Reflections: Scarriff Bay Community Radio will have a series of programmes on Sunday evenings to help your Lenten Reflections. A mixture of reflection and music they will hopefully provide some time out for you in these days. The programmes will be broadcast at 6pm.

Sacraments: There have been a number of inquiries about dates of sacramental celebrations; unfortunately we are not in a position to set any dates and it will likely be early March before we are able to do so. Please keep checking the parish website for any updates.
