

Parish/Diocesan News

Our public celebration of Masses are well underway and thanks to everyone for your continued co-operation and support regarding the numbers allowed at masses (no more than 50), and the wearing of face masks which is required by all who attend. Please make sure you observe social distancing and hand sanitising. If you can spare a moment to help wipe down surfaces after Mass, it would be most appreciated and don't forget to do so when visiting a church other than at mass times. Don't leave it to someone else!

Guidelines for attending Mass:

- Facemasks must be worn in church during Mass and other services.
- Please sanitise your hands when entering church at any time.
- A capacity of 50 people is permitted for Mass; this includes funerals and weddings.
- Holy Communion should only be received in the hand.
- Please respect these guidelines and thank you for your understanding and patience at this time; hopefully our continued efforts will bring about more relaxed conditions in due course.
- Please help to sanitise the church, wiping the seats after Mass or after a personal visit.

Online broadcast of Mass: will be reduced from this week; Mass will be available this week on Wednesday and Friday at 10am and Sunday at 11am.

Exams: We keep in our prayers all those doing exams at the moment. Spirit of God, be with all those doing exams; enlighten students to choose the correct questions. Focus their minds to answer each questions clearly. Holy Spirit, grant them peace of mind and calmness of soul. Holy Spirit, come help them during exams and always.

Missals: For those using daily and Sunday missals - ordinary time resumes this Monday; use Sunday cycle B, weekday cycle 1, 8th week in ordinary time.

Baptisms: Bookings for baptisms are now being accepted; please contact the Parish Office or Fr David. Please note that no more than 10 people are allowed to attend a baptism at this time

Contributions: Thanks for your continued financial support of the parish at this time. A number of payments have been received through the diocesan online donation facility and we are very grateful. All donations made through that service come to the parish.

Rosary for the month of May: Each Friday evening at 730pm the Rosary will be said in the grounds of St Molua's Church, weather permitting, otherwise in the Church itself. Everyone is welcome to come and honour our Lady, during the month of May. All HSE guidelines will be adhered to. If you are unable to attend maybe you will pray with us from your home.

May Safeguarding Month: An Adult Safeguarding Policy for all Munster Dioceses has been introduced into the diocese. 'Inspired by gospel values, the commitment of Pope Francis, and in compliance with law we will strive to ensure the participation and welfare of all adults who may be vulnerable in the life of the Church.
