### Parish/Diocesan News

Thank you for your continued cooperation and support with regard to the health and safety standards for all attending Mass. If you have a moment to spare in helping to sanitise surfaces after Mass it would be very much appreciated and of course please do so after your own personal visits.

Church capacity is still restricted to 50 for all events; you can help us to stay within the limits by attending Mass on a day other than Sunday when suitable. This will fulfil your Sunday obligation.

Please remember that social spacing in church is still necessary – maintain a distance in seating and you are required to wear a mask, thank you for your co-operation and understanding.

### Guidelines for attending Mass:

- Facemasks must be worn in church during Mass and other services.
- Please sanitise your hands when entering church at any time.
- A capacity of 50 people is permitted for Mass; this includes funerals and weddings.
- Holy Communion should only be received in the hand.
- Please respect these guidelines and thank you for your understanding and patience at this time; hopefully our continued efforts will bring about more relaxed conditions in due course.
- Please help to sanitise the church, wiping the seats after Mass or after a personal visit.

**Cafe at Ogonnelloe Exchange:** will re-open on Saturday 10 July from 11.00am to 3.00pm. Clarecare will operate the Cafe as part of their Connect Clare social enterprise venture, which is a new Clarecare initiative aiming to reconnect members of the public through conversation and community engagement in a café environment. Our cafe in Ogonnelloe is a location where Connect Clare is being piloted for a number of months. You can drop in for a tea or coffee and some hot and cold food every Saturday from 11.00am to 3.00pm, to meet friends and have a chat. Or if you are passing by you can call in for a takeaway drink or snack. If the cafe is successful its opening could be extended to other days of the week. This is a great opportunity for our community to support a new venture in Ogonnelloe. We hope to see you there.

**The O'Gonnelloe Community Development Plan** is going to print shortly. The Planning Group would like to thank all who contributed to the development process and to the final document, especially those who submitted written recommendations and suggestions when the draft was circulated. These recommendations have been incorporated into the body of the plan or passed on to the leaders of the different strands to be implemented in the course of their work. The final document and a summary will be circulated by email through the range of organisations, clubs and societies in O'Gonnelloe, and through the community email. Copies of the plan and a summary will be available at the community hall and in the churches. Bound copies will be available for reference in the libraries at Scarriff and Killaloe and in the parish hall, while copies will also be given to the school. The Planning Group is delighted to see the plan published. It is now up to all of us to engage with the leaders of the different strands and bring it to life.
