# Parish/Diocesan News

This Sunday, 17th October we mark the opening of this Synodal Process entitled. For a Synodal Church: communion, participation and mission. This Synodal Process coincides with the start of the two-year Synodal Pathway for the Catholic Church in Ireland which will lead, in time, to a National Synodal Assembly in Ireland. We pray that the next two years will be a time of prayer, listening and discernment, involving a consultative conversation. This will allow all people - both within the Church and in society at large, to share their insights into the Catholic Church in Ireland - past, present and future - so that we can prepare for a National Synodal Assembly in the coming years.

COVID-19 - Reframing the Challenge, Continuing Our Recovery and Reconnecting (www.Gov.ie): Religious services and ceremonies (for example Baptisms, Weddings & Funerals) can proceed with 50% of venue capacity, regardless of immunity status of attendees. All other measures designed to minimise necessary physical interaction during services should be maintained. Thank you for your continued cooperation and support with regard to the health and safety standards for all attending Mass. **Guidelines for attending Mass:** 

- Facemasks must be worn in church during Mass and other services.
- Social spacing in church is still necessary – maintain a distance in seating
- Please sanitise your hands when entering church at any time.
- 50% of the churches normal capacity; from 6th September and further changes from 20th September.
- Holy Communion should only be received in the hand.

Please help to sanitise the church, wiping the seats after Mass or after a personal visit. October and World Mission Sunday Next weekend we will celebrate World Mission Sunday, the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. Worryingly, it is in jeopardy. The pandemic means that less of us can physically attend Mass, meaning less offerings in the basket.
