Public Consultation Event - Proposed Limerick to Scariff Greenway: Waterways Ireland are holding a Public Consultation Event regarding the proposed Limerick to Scariff Greenway in Ogonnelloe Hall from 4pm to 7pm on Thursday 28 April. Maps and drawings of the proposed Greenway will be on display and Waterways Ireland will have staff present to explain their proposals. They will display 3 possible routes for the Greenway through Ogonnelloe and they will invite comments from the community on people's preferred route. Waterways Ireland will subsequently publish their preferred route for the Greenway and they will then lodge a planning application for the full project. If planning permission is granted they will then proceed with the construction of the Greenway.
