Community/Local News

St Vincent de Paul Church gate collection: Many thanks to those who contributed to this collection. A total of €557.57 was raised. Hall update: The first phase of work to the Parish Hall was started in Mar '18 and the second in Sept '18. The total cost of the development including both phases, sheds, canopy, projector, screen lighting and sound is €302,000. After receiving grants we took out a loan of €70,000, of which to date we owe €48,991. This loan will be repaid in 2029. Our main income is Hall rental and the monthly envelopes and without these we could not meet our repayments. Our appreciation and thanks goes to the community for their continued support. We have a wonderful Community Centre with great facilities which the community of O'Gonnelloe can be very proud of and with your continued support we will be able to meet our monthly payments and finish the loan.

East Clare to raise its voice with concert in aid of victims of war in Palestine: The East Clare performing arts community has come together in response to the horrific impact of the war in Palestine on children and families to put together a one-off show this coming Sunday, December 17 in Scarriff GAA Hall at 8pm. The 'East Clare for Peace in Palestine' concert will see some 20 plus of our best known singers, musicians and story-tellers from Bodyke/Tuamgraney, Ogonnelloe, Scarriff and Whitegate deliver what promises to be a very special performance of favourite songs and stories of peace and Christmas. Proceeds will go to the Irish Emergency Alliance, an alliance of Action Aid, Christian Aid, Trócaire, World Vision, TearFund, and Plan International, who have together established a 'Middle East Emergency Crisis' in response to the ongoing horror in Gaza. Tickets are on sale on Eventbrite and can also be purchased at Rodgers' and Bane's shops in Scariff, Treacy's in Tuamgraney, Josie Anne's in Ogonnelloe and McDermott's in Whitegate. Tickets are priced at €20 each and are expected to sell out guickly so the advice is to book early. Your support for this worthy cause and a night of great East Clare entertainment would be greatly welcome.
